Sculpture Emphasis: soft sculpture supplies:

Required supplies for all options:

- A pen or marker (can be ballpoint, felt-tip, roller ball, gel pen, and can include different colors, sizes, and types if you wish.), set of graphite pencils (2B, 4B, 6B) and kneaded eraser.
- 11x14 Spiral, Coptic, stab-bound, or hardbound sketchbook—can be handmade or purchased. This will be developed as your own personal atlas of learning and art.

Also ensure that you have the following supplies if focusing on soft sculpture sculptural media:

- Modeling clay
- Sculpture media option-- soft sculpture (please note that not all items are available at the online store)
 - Fabric of different types—can be scrap fabric, as well as socks, quilt fabric, knee-high
 nylons, as well as cotton stockinette (the type used for covering injured limbs or
 appendages—comes in a roll of 2-4 inches wide, and many yards long, but stretches a
 lot, for needle-sculpting heads, limbs, etc. on soft sculptures and soft dolls.
 - Polyfil stuffing and/or unspun wool fibers (link to Hobby Lobby page with fiberfill)
 - Thread and needle (a sewing machine is also helpful, but not required) embroidery thread
 - o Doll needles
 - Additional materials and items, from buttons to felt, to lace, yarn, google-eyes, etc.
 - Please note that you can also use <u>armature wire</u> to support a large soft sculpture and thinner wire for hands and fingers (also listed in the dick blick online supplies list)
 - IF you choose to use this approach, you should also get <u>pre-wrap for sprains</u> and injuries (yes, it is a first aid material), which is a thin foam wrapping that can cover the wire armature and make it more appropriate for use in a soft figure.
 - Paper clay or polymer clay for faces, details, etc. (listed in the dick blick online supplies list)
 - Acrylic paint and brushes (listed in the dick blick online supplies list)
 - Yarn or unspun fibers for hair (listed in the dick blick online supplies list)
- AND additional supplies of your choice for one or more of the other areas of emphasis, based
 on your areas of experience and your goals for the class. You may download and browse any
 of the other supplies lists to add to your main media focus.
